ITEMS OF INTEREST

SCHOOL BOOKS FOR LITHUANIA - by Al Gustaff, a member of St. John's Parish in Frederick.

In 1992, a few months after Lithuania won its freedom from Soviet domination, my wife and I traveled there and taught English at a Teacher's college for 10 months. We learned that English was taught to children in public schools using obsolete methods and texts filled with anti-U.S. propaganda.

We returned to this country and with the help of Edward Budelis, a retired English teacher, found that county schools discard thousands of books each year. In the past three years we have collected and sent over 7,000 used English books in good condition to Lithuanian schools. The response from teachers was enthusiastic.

English has become an important world language. It is necessary in world commerce and trade, travel, science and technology. It is critical for Lithuanian children to learn English. In the future, as they replace the present Soviet trained leaders, they will help their country to be competitive in the world.

It is our goal to send a container with about 25,000 books to Lithuanian schools. We are now expanding our collecting to Baltimore and Frederick counties. A Lithuanian businessman in Baltimore is providing space for sorting, packing and storing boxes until they are shipped.

We ask the Knights of Columbus to consider providing a community service for this international project, "Books for Lithuania". A few retired men with small trucks could ship boxes of books from the Frederick County warehouses to Baltimore. I have other volunteers to handle them there. This needs to be done probably every 2 or 3 months and only when county warehouses are open. I have three small truckloads ready to go RIGHT NOW!
